SMARTBoards	75	Can be used with non-SFS laptops (see note about Virus Protection). Should indicate need to use SMARTBoard prior to conference. LINQ connection is also possible with advance notice to SFS IT staff. Presenter is responsible for installing Smartboard notebook software on laptop. Prior to presentation, presenter must verify the connection and functionality. There are no Ink-Aware applications installed on SFS computers.
Digital projector	In all but 7 classrooms	Different manufacturers and models. Usable with personal laptop and SFS computers.
Operating system	Windows XP	No Macintosh computers are available for presentations.
Web access	Wired-available in all rooms. Wireless-most of campus.	Presenters can access internet via SFS Wireless Lan.
Web Blocker	Barracuda Web Filter	If presenters have specific websites, they should verify access prior to conference. Adding sites to our acceptable list requires administrator approval.
Other hardware	peripherals-printer, scanner, digital camera, pocket PC, probe, iPod, external hard drive, stick/flash memory stick, card reader, etc.	Plug and play with USB connection only. No software installation will be done. Sticks must be scanned for viruses, no .exe files can be installed on SFS computers.
Software	Microsoft Office Applications	NO personal software will be loaded onto SFS owned computers.
		SFS operates a Citrix network environment using Terminal Services for application access and use. MS Office applications, are installed only on SFS computers located in computer labs. Presenters should be aware of this if they are scheduled to present using an SFS owned computer in a regular classroom. Microsoft Viewer for Word, Excel and Access are installed on all SFS computers.
	Virus Protection	Currently, the SFS IT dept manually checks for the presence of active virus protection on any non-SFS laptop (PC and Mac) before the laptop can access our wi-lan. We will send out info on how this will be done at KORCOS for presenters and attendees.
